Summit Uganda Workshop Itinerary

JANUARY 25 FEBRUARY 1, 2024

January 25


Fly from Nairobi to Kigali, Rwanda for those continuing from Kenya. Fly directly into Kigali, Rwanda for those first joining us in for the gorillas.

January 26

After a restful morning at the hotel, we will have a brief **city tour of Kigali** and a visit to the Genocide Memorial Centre, followed by lunch and a 3 hour drive to Mgahinga. Dinner and Overnight at local hotel.

January 27

Gorilla trek in Mgahinga National Park. Situated on the border between Uganda, Rwanda, and the Congo, this park protects a large portion of the Virunga **Volcanoes**. A large habituated group of Mountain Gorillas known as the Nyakagezi Family can be seen here with a 95% success rate. Once the family is located we will have one hour to observe and photograph their behavior! After returning from the trek, we will drive 2 hours to Bwindi Impenetrable Forest. Overnight at Ichumbi Gorilla Lodge.





January 28

Gorilla trek in Bwindi Impenetrable Forest National Park. This park is home to nearly **half of the world's population of Mountain Gorillas!** Of the 36 gorilla families in the park, 19 have been habituated. We will hike into the park with one of the rangers who protect these gorillas, and once a family is located we will get to spend a full hour photographing them in very close proximity. During the hike in and out of the park we will likely encounter numerous other wildlife species. Overnight at Ichumbi Gorilla Lodge.

January 29

Drive to Queen Elizabeth National Park (6 hours) for a game drive and **Kazinga Channel Boat Cruise with wildlife viewing along the channel.** Picnic lunches en route to the Park. Overnight at a Safari Lodge.

January 30

Morning game drive in Queen Elizabeth National Park. After lunch at the lodge we will drive 3 hours to Kibale National Park. Overnight at Kibale Guest Cottages.

January 31

Early morning Chimp trek in Kibale National Park. This park is home to the **highest diversity of primates in all of Africa**, and likely the best place in the world to see **Chimpanzees!** In addition to chimps, we will have the opportunity to see an additional 12 species of primates and nearly **400 species of birds**. Overnight at Kibale Guest Cottages.

February 1

Breakfast and drive to Entebbe (6 hours). Evening/late night flights back to the US.
