The faculty will stay at the Alpine House in downtown Jackson, however the Alpine House is a small bed and breakfast and will fill up, so don't wait too long to reserve your space. That being said, most workshop sessions are held at the National Museum of Wildlife Art, just north of town, so you may choose any of the hotels in the town of Jackson that fit your budget. All will be roughly equidistant to the workshop classes.

Many of you have inquired about renting cars and we agree it is a wise choice. Think of this workshop as an investment, one in which you will fully benefit from if you have access to travel when and where you need it. We understand that budgeting is important, and you may find that once you meet other workshop participants you will meet someone interested in sharing car expenses as well. A number of great locations to photograph are a decent driving distance from town, not to mention the daily trips out to the museum.

We'll be updating the downloadable online packets about two months prior to the event, when we have a majority of the details finalized and a complete instructor staff announced. Please be aware that while Nikon is supplying equipment for student use, we ask that you bring all the camera equipment that you normally use. You must also bring a laptop (either Mac or PC) or some other work station on which to download and edit your images.

When making travel plans, please note that we are also planning a day devoted to the Digital Photography 101, on Sunday, September 28th. These sessions are designed to get you up to speed on the advancements in digital cameras, software and workflow, as well as general photography best practices to give you a strong footing with which to start the week. We will have a reception for all participants Sunday evening, in the Museum Members' Lounge. We would like you join us for appetizers, drinks and the company of fellow workshop participants and instructors. The week will conclude with a banquet on Friday evening, October 3rd, at the Teton Pines Resort. The dinner will the wrap up around 10 p.m. with many participants and faculty heading to the bar for some final hours of socializing, so please plan on departing Jackson on Saturday in order to fully enjoy Friday's events.

If you have paid only your deposit, please remember that the remainder of the registration fee needs to be paid two months in advance. Just prior to that deadline, we will email you a reminder that we will automatically charge your card for the remainder of your tuition. If you would prefer another method of payment, or you paid your deposit by check, please contact us at that time to finalize payment. Tuition deposits will be refunded in full up to June 30<sup>th</sup>. After that time, if you need to cancel for any reason, your paid deposit/tuition is non-refundable, but can be applied in full to a future workshop of your choosing.
